**Position:** Lawn Care Technician (Applicator)

**Required Experience:** Candidate needs past experience in the lawn care industry as an applicator applying both dry and liquid fertilizers/herbicides and pesticides.

**On-The-Job Training:** Yes. Candidate will train under an Ohio licensed pesticide applicator and may be required to work with trainer until abilities are proven.

**Required Hours:** Depending on the candidate, this can be either full-time or part-time employment. Working on inclement weather days can be optional.

**Starting Salary Range:** Starting salary to be based upon experience and/or knowledge.

**Description:** Candidate must be willing and able to perform physical outdoor labor, have a positive attitude, be willing to receive instruction, and be able to perform a wide array of tasks. This may include the use of chemicals, fertilizers, and power equipment. Most common duties will include; applying fertilizers, herbicides, and other pesticides. Candidate must be able to lift at least 50#, push a fertilizer spreader, and be able to drag a hose several hundred feet at a time while properly applying liquid product. Candidate must possess competency on safe and proper operations of pesticide applications and Ohio pesticide laws. Candidate must possess strong mathematical skills for job-related calculations. Candidate does not need a pesticide license, however obtaining one will be **highly recommended**. Having mechanical abilities and snow removal related experience is a major benefit that will further enhance employment. No sales are involved at this time, however, a professional appearance; honest and ethical manner is required. **A valid driver's license and good driving record is a must.** Advancement is likely and is highly encouraged if candidate so desires. Drug testing may be required.
